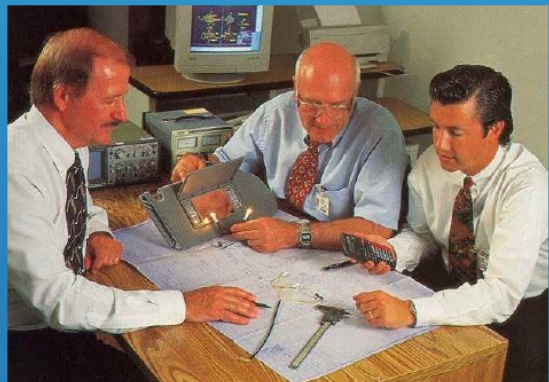

For her first order of business, the newly installed president of the Alamo Chapter of ASHRAE, call on the chapter historian to start a series of articles for the Squirrel Cage, the Chapter's monthly newsletter. Said articles to be on Question and Answer addressed to past Presidents of the Alamo Chapter.

Herewith, the first question and answer.

Subject: Manuel F. Lizcano, P.E. Past President 1983-94

At the last Board of Governor's meeting of the Christopher Garcia administration (2010-2011, the, then, President Elect Jennifer King, asked Manuel Lizcano, whom she had just appointed as Chapter Historian for the 2011-12 year, the question of the century; "How long have you been Historian?"

Here now is the answer that had been on the minds of every Squirrel Cage reader since inception of The Corner of History:

"Joe Rohats, a key member of Todd-Ford Construction Company and member of the Honors and Awards Committee of the Alamo Chapter asked me If I would accept the position of chapter historian. To which I answered that I was not old enough to be a historian, "You do not have to live the history just gather and safe guard the history of the chapter". "Would be honored" I said, he handed me a file box and I was in business.

That evening, I went through the files and was surprise that I knew some of these early pioneers. I worked for 'Berretta Greenslade and Associates (BGA) at the time. They were a Civil, Structural, Mechanical, Plumbing and Electrical company. Jack Berretta, P.E. was a civil Engineer with a 2 digit PE license number and member of the Texas Board of Professional Engineers.

The office of BGA was located at the corner of N.St.Mary's St. and Euclid. The building is still there but is no longer and engineering firm.

The building had two tenants BGA and LK Pakette Company. Lk Pawkett was an equipment representative and an active member of the Alamo chapter known at the time as the South West Texas (SWT) chapter American Society of Heating and Ventilation Engineers (ASHVE). When ASHVE and ASR merged in 1958-59 to form ASHRAE, it turned out that there were two chapters called SWT chapter. The SWT of Houston was former prior to the San Antonio forming and naming its Chapter. So a new name was needed. LS Pawkett took up the challenge and held a contest in search of the new name he donated a bottle of his favorite scotch as a prize. There is no record of the participants or list of suggested names or who received the prize but we do have the name of the Alamo chapter of ASHRAE.

A month after I accepted the historian position, Joe Rohats come back to me as member of the nominating committee and asked me if I would accept a position on the board of governors. I told him that as long as it did not disqualify me as Chapter Historian I would accept. I emphasized that if I had to choose between the two I would keep the historian position. He knew he had made the right choice. I went on through the chair on to Chapter President 1983-1984

I was appointed Chapter Historian in 1979 and every year since.

I was appointed Regional Historian for Region VIII in 1984 and reappointed each year through 1998

In 1991 I was appointed to the Historical Committee at National level and serve till 1998

In 1998, Leo Stambaugh Regional Director retired me from the Regional historian position make a historic title of Regional Historian Emeritus, Region VIII.

I was called back to duty as Regional Historian by Ken Fault when the appointed Regional Historian had to terminate his tenure unexpectedly. I served the reaming term which ended June 30, 2011.

So here I am back where I started, Chapter historian a year at a time.

The Rest really is History.
